

Discussion Guide: *The Summer Scrapbook*

1. All three girls are dreading their time apart. Which girl's summer do you think would be the most fun for you, and which would be the least fun? Why?
2. Becca is terrified of speaking in front of others. How do her experiences at Camp Whistling Ridge help her come out of her shell?
3. Cat's first impression of Von is negative, as is Ava's first impression of Derrick. How and why do their feelings change over the course of the summer?
4. How does Ava's experience on the London Eye contrast with how she's generally used her phone and social media before this summer?
5. Why is Becca reluctant to forgive Candace and Danny even after they apologize for stranding her near the fence? What do you think convinces her to give them another chance?
6. Over the course of the story, each of the girls must resolve a conflict with her two best friends as well as a conflict with at least one new friend. What similarities do you notice about their ways of resolving these conflicts? What ingredients do you think are needed to repair any damaged friendship?
7. What outcome of the girls' summers most surprised you and why?
8. What do you think the new school year will hold for Ava, Becca, and Cat?
